#### **High Progress**

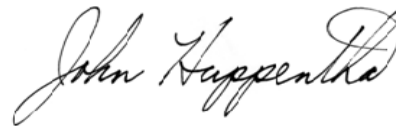
- an 'A' or 'B' letter grade
