Trustworthiness is being worthy of trust. People can rely on you to do your best, to keep your word and to follow through on your commitments. You do what you say you will do.

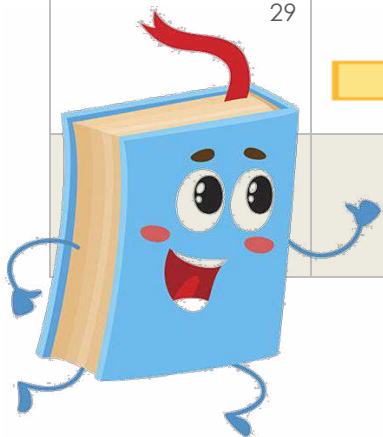
